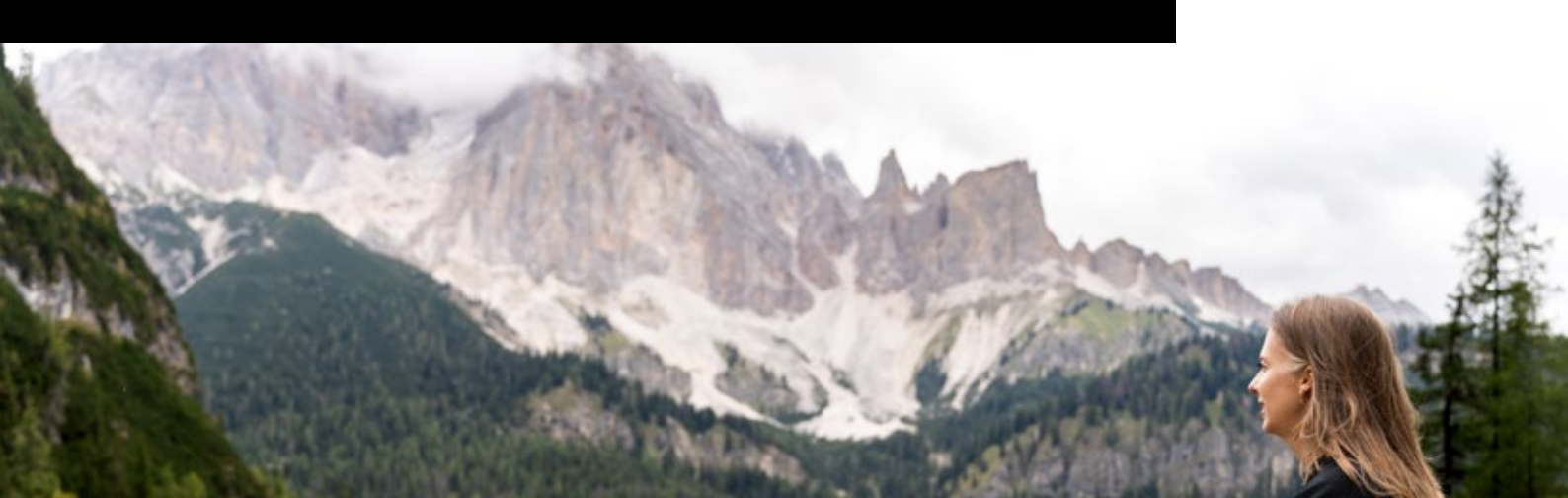
Sustainable from start to finish

Sustainability and biobased plastics are terms we often hear, but their meanings aren't always clear. What does it mean for a product or process to be sustainable? And what exactly is biobased plastic?

At Eurobottle, sustainability is at our core. We produce in our own factory in the Netherlands. Our bottles are made from biobased HDPE and LDPE, derived from sugarcane – a renewable resource. This innovative material captures CO2 during growth, resulting in a negative carbon footprint.

Our bottles are not only reusable but also 100% recyclable in regular waste streams, promoting a circular economy. By choosing Eurobottle, you're investing in a product that's eco-friendly from production to disposal, helping to create a more sustainable future for our planet.





Discover our goal

We aim to set the standard for bottles that are responsibly made, long-lasting, and fully recyclable. We create reusable bottles that keep brands visible for years while continuously improving how we make them.

Our bottles are built to last and help reduce unnecessary plastic waste. For the user, they're practical and made for everyday use; for the customer, they're a marketing tool that reflects a conscious choice.

Produced in our own factory in the Netherlands, we keep control over design, quality, and every step of the process.

That's how we create real value.

For brands, for users, and for the world around us.





Plant-based material

Instead of crude oil, our bottles are made from plant-based material. The main ingredient comes from the leftovers of sugarcane. While growing, the sugarcane plant absorbs CO₂, making it a natural and renewable source.

Fully recyclable



Plant-based PE has the same quality as regular plastic. It will be fully recycled in the regular waste streams, just like any other plastic bottle.

Smart transformation



The leftovers from sugarcane are turned into the base material for our bottles. With this process no food is wasted, and no extra land is needed.

From a sustainably sourced sugarcane into a 100% recyclable biobased material.

Why not use recycled material?

It's a question we often get, and a fair one. In Europe, recycled plastic is legally not allowed for food-contact products, except for PET bottles from the deposit system. That's why we use the best alternative: biobased PE.

Is biobased PE also biodegradable?

No, biobased means our bottles are made from renewable resources. That doesn't make them biodegradable, and that's a conscious choice. Biodegradable materials aren't yet suitable or approved for food-safe use.

Our advanced factory, located in the Netherlands, has more than 45 years of experience with the production of both small and large quantities.

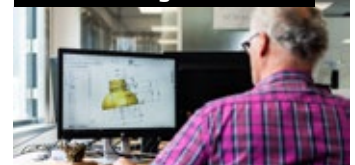
Our commitment to quality is confirmed by our certifications according to the ISO 9001:2015 and ISO 22000:2018 standards, which guarantee that our production processes meet the highest international standards of quality and food safety.

Our machines



In our factory we use extrusion blow molding for the bottles, and injection molding for caps and nozzles. These techniques ensure high-quality, sustainable drinking solutions with innovative design.

In-house design



Thanks to our fully in-house production, we offer the possibility to design and produce completely customized products that perfectly match the identity and needs of your organization.

How our products are printed and assembled

The printing of our products happens at Bewel, in Belgium, Hasselt. Bewel is an organization that employs people who are distanced from the labor market. People with passion, dedication and the qualities to perform and optimize the most diverse tasks or processes. This collaboration offers a total package, including storage, printing, assembly and shipping.

At Bewel, our products are screen printed with certified food-safe, high-quality inks. This results in durable and safe printing on our products.

The assembly of our products also takes place at Bewel, directly after printing.

Recyclable & responsible

We are dedicated to making responsible choices with our products. Our sports- and water bottles are designed to be fully recyclable, ensuring minimal impact on the environment and supporting a circular economy.

We only use polyethylene (PE) as material, this way our bottles can be fully recycled through regular waste streams. We avoid silicone seals to keep recycling simple, while ensuring our bottles remain completely leak-proof.

We use green energy and follow our first time right principle to minimize waste. Our bottles are designed for long-term use, reducing single-use plastics and promoting a sustainable lifestyle.

Carbon-free black



Black can be difficult for recycling machines to detect the correct material. For this we are using a carbon-free black colour which can be recognized and sorted in the recycling streams. This choice supports more efficient recycling.

Certified food-safe inks



Only certified food-safe inks are being used for the printing. These meet the highest standards for safety and quality. Their strong adhesion guarantees durable prints that stay beautiful throughout the bottle's lifetime.



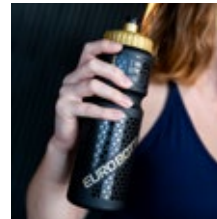
Signature Series

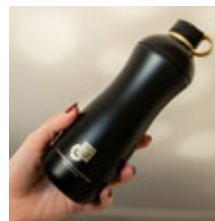

As a UNICEF Business Buddie, we support UNICEF by donating 1% of every Oasis water bottle we sell. We wanted to contribute to and support the sustainable Plastic Bricks project in Ivory Coast, where plastic waste is recycled into building blocks for classrooms.

A brick for the future

Eurobottle supports UNICEF's future-focused initiatives. We donate 1% from each Oasis water bottle sale to UNICEF's project in Ivory Coast, which recycles plastic waste into classroom building materials, empowering women and promoting education.

Plastic Bricks in Ivory Coast

Côte d'Ivoire struggles with plastic waste and low school attendance. UNICEF tackles both by buying plastic from underpaid women, recycling it into classroom materials, and providing waste management training, creating sustainable solutions.

UNICEF 'Plastic Bricks'

In Ivory Coast, only 5% of plastic waste is recycled, mainly by poor women and youth. They sell waste on the black market at low prices, contributing to school absenteeism. UNICEF provides training in waste management and entrepreneurship, and opened a recycling plant buying plastic directly at fair prices. The recycled plastic is used to build classrooms. This improves living conditions and prevents diseases caused by stored waste.

Responsible consumption and production

We use biobased materials and maintain quality with our “First Time Right” approach. Our Oasis water bottle exemplifies efficiency, using 40% less material than conventional bottles, demonstrating responsible production.



Climate action

As UNICEF Business Buddies, we support Ivory Coast’s plastic recycling project, creating jobs, producing classroom materials, and promoting sustainability while raising living standards for all involved.



Life below water

We actively research and test alternative, eco-friendly materials such as PHA to reduce our environmental impact. Additionally, we focus on developing reusable products to minimize plastic waste and promote sustainable consumption patterns.



Life on land

Utilizing residuals from sugarcane production as raw materials reduces the need for additional land use and resource extraction. This approach supports sustainable land management and helps preserve ecosystems and biodiversity.

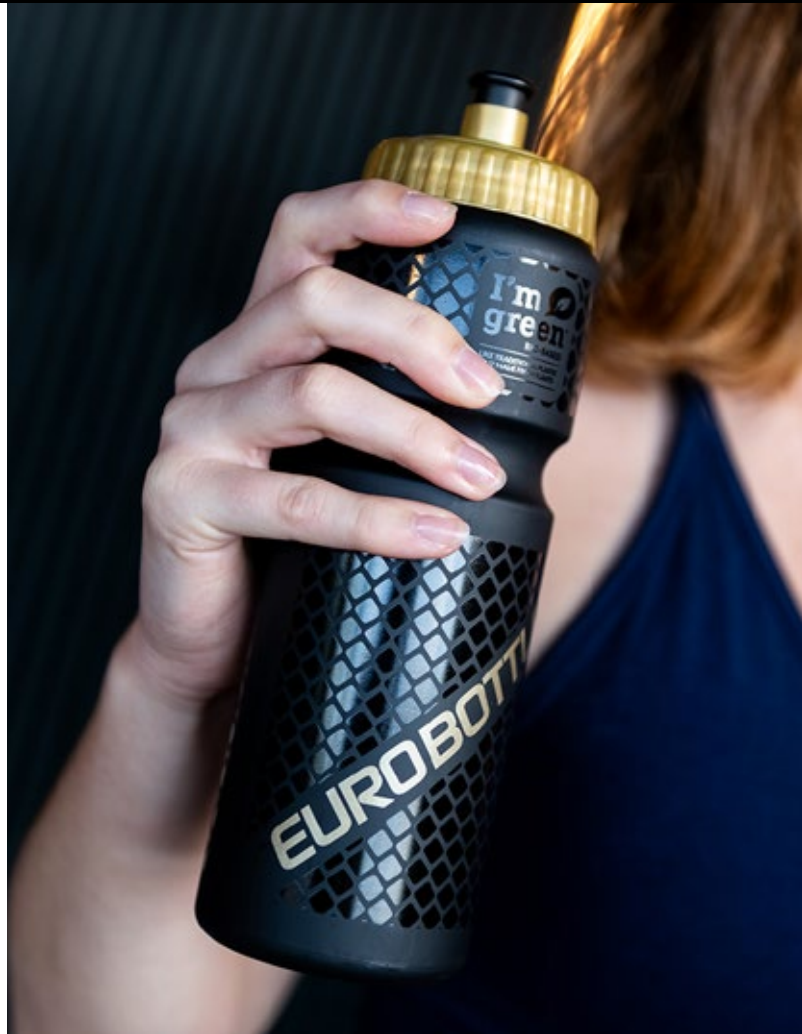
